Sister Mary Francis entered the Sisters of Charity of Seton Hill on September 8, 1933

Sitting in her wheelchair, Sister Mary Francis Irvin gazed upon the artwork hanging on her wall. Each piece represented memories of her God, her life and her loved ones. Her icon from Sister Estelle; an original piece of calligraphy from her dear friend Kevin; and the angel that Marjorie gave her: each piece stirred her soul. Sister Mary Francis was a brilliant artist whose works inspired and amazed. As a teacher, she could bring out the best in her students. To her friends, she was uplifting and entertaining. But now, it seemed that life was slowly being covered up by the diminishing effects of age and physical losses.

Not a day went by, however, that she did not have visitors. She was loved by many, not in the least by her house companions, the Sisters of Charity of Seton Hill, residents of the motherhouse, Caritas Christi. Several times a day a Sister would stop by to bring cheer and comfort.

One day, she received a visitor who had been a student of hers. Sister Anita Schulte was an education major at Seton Hill University and was in Sister Mary Francis' class,

"Techniques in Art Education." The year was 1956 and Sister Anita was struggling to master her assignments. Though Sister Anita worked hard and was eager to succeed, she lacked love and appreciation of the art in her world. At

Sister Mary Francis Irvin died at Caritas Christi on January 8, 2011, at the age of 96. Many of her paintings adorn the hallways and rooms at Doran Hall, Ennis Hall and Caritas Christi. She designed chapel appointments, including a crucifix, chalice, paten, monstrance and candlesticks as well as the emblem and ring that are worn as the congregational signs of identification for the Sisters of Charity. A hallmark of her achievement was in the design of the 110 original stained-glass panels placed in the Assumption Hall Chapel and later transferred to the chapel windows at Caritas Christi, the motherhouse of the Sisters of Charity. In reflecting on her life as Sister of Charity and artist, Sister Mary Francis once stated, "An artist is not a special person. Every person is a special kind of artist and I believe that our entire congregation consists of sisters who are special kinds of artists."

one point, when she was about to give up, Sister Mary Francis spoke five words that transformed her.

"Think outside of the box."

Those words hit the mark. Years later Sister Anita founded the Elizabeth Seton Montessori School. She was director of the school for 40 years. The teaching that she received from Sister Mary Francis now flowed through her, stimulating the minds of young children by engaging their hands in meaningful activities.

In 2008, Sister Anita retired from her duties at the school and became interested in ministering to the elderly infirm Sisters at Caritas Christi. On a visit to the motherhouse, she made a surprise visit to her beloved teacher from Seton Hill University, Sister Mary Francis. As she walked into her room, she became aware of Sister Mary Francis' condition and bit down hard on her lip. After a deep breath, she smiled,

"Well, hello, Sister Mary Francis. It's me, Sister Anita Schulte."

A slight movement from Sister Mary Francis' head let Sister Anita know that she had been heard. Slowly, Sister Mary Francis turned and gazed upon her visitor. In that moment, Sister Anita received a request: "Design for me an activity whereby I can reveal my thoughts and feelings and have a sense of accomplishment." She did not hear the words with her ears. She felt them with her heart. Sister Mary Francis was once again taking on the role of instructor and had given Sister Anita an assignment.

Sister Anita wasted no time beginning her assignment. She discovered the work of Dr. Cameron Camp, Director of Research for Dementia Patients at the Myers Research Institute in Cleveland. His research showed that elderly people with dementia need cognitive stimulation along with opportunities to successfully and meaningfully interact with their physical and social environments on a regular basis. He taught that people with dementia are, first and foremost, people; they are people with special needs. They have the need to feel a sense of worth, the need to express their thoughts and feelings, the need to have a sense of belonging, and the need to have a sense of accomplishment. Sister Anita discovered a correlation that existed between assisting the development of the intelligence of a young child and working with a dementia patient. They both rely on the primary instrument used in developing a motor memory; the human hand. Possessing a memory of its own, the hand provides the key which unlocks much of what has been stored in the cognitive memory.

Sister Anita began to visit her teacher on a regular basis. Her plan was to awaken the memory in the artist's hands through touch. On each visit, she would bring a bag of objects each of which felt different to the touch; smooth rocks, burlap, velvet. They progressed quickly in more than just the sense of touch. Soon, Sister Mary Francis was speaking sentences. On one visit, Sister Mary Francis gave her student one more assignment, "Help me to create one more picture." This time, Sister Anita heard it with her ears.

Children, scholars dream together in Seton Arts

“It’s a special program helping children to work toward their dream,” Kalie Mills, a Seton Arts Scholar, describes the Seton Art Program for inner city children. Kalie is a Seton Hill University graduate in Studio Arts and has been a Scholar for four years. She became a Scholar with a friend, Chelsea Trettel, because they “thought it would be a cool way to get involved.”



Dreams are achieved on several levels in Seton Arts. The children, ages seven to twelve, engage in art, music and drama activities for seven Saturdays. Parents may come with them and be part of the program. The teachers in this unique initiative are Seton Hill University students who design and carry out the lessons and act as mentors for the children.

Sister Kathleen McGrady, S.C. directs the total program while Sister Joan Hopper, S.C. specializes in the visual arts.

“It is the most fun and the hardest work I have ever done!” exclaims Elizabeth Sinnott, a graduating SHU senior majoring in Music Education. Elizabeth has been a Seton Arts Scholar for two years and enjoys working with the different groups of children in Pittsburgh and New Kensington. She has discovered “lots of different backgrounds” in the children and loves finding their “hidden talents.” (She says she has found quite a few!)

Chelsea Bloam, a senior and a Music and Theatre major, has worked for three years with Seton Arts. She enjoys seeing the children’s show at the



end of the seven weeks and watching the children develop and grow during the time she has spent with them.

Senior John Olearchik, who has been a Seton Arts Scholar for two years, enjoys the positive reaction from the students “who join the program because they want to be part of it.” He likes the challenge of being thrown into a unique environment that the scholars have to become comfortable with, to provide a well-rounded, arts-based experience for the students. John is a Music Education major.

In “providing the students with the experience to work toward their dreams” the SHU students learn to collaborate with one another. They find it challenging to create a new, interesting program at the beginning of each semester and to decide how to carry it out in only seven Saturdays. John Olearchick has learned to “think on my feet” because lesson plans sometimes give way to improvised activities created by the Scholars depending upon the needs and interests of the children.

Some of the Seton Arts Scholars are aspiring teachers and feel that the program has been

a great help. Chelsea Bloam knows that she is meant to teach children and the Seton Arts Program helped her realize this. Elizabeth Sinnott is grateful for the opportunity to “practice” teaching and John Olearchick feels more relaxed and able to develop his skills without the pressures of observation and grades.

The best thing about Seton Arts overall is the children the Scholars teach and mentor. The Scholars love the final day when the students perform and demonstrate the music, visual arts and drama they have drawn into themselves and when they say that they do not want the program to end. But the final day is also the worst day for the Scholars because they must leave the children and all that they shared.

As the Scholars move on with their lives as teachers, arts enthusiasts, artists and performers they will carry the memories of those early Saturday mornings in their hearts and say with Chelsea Bloam. “It is probably the most rewarding activity I have been involved with at Seton Hill!”

"There was usually a common thread that ran through most of Sister Mary Francis' teaching techniques," Sister Anita says. "It was her way of making us think outside the box. 'Use your God-given gifts and create something the world has never experienced.' Well, thank God for Pizza Hut because that's where I found my solution; a simple pizza pan with a shallow edge into which Sister could place her hand comfortably. All I had to add was a bag of yellow cornmeal and we had a perfect canvas.



It was Monday morning, my day to spend with Sister Mary Francis. I arrived at her room carrying my bag containing the pizza pan and a bag of cornmeal. I told her I had a surprise but it wasn't chocolate chip cookies. She watched me sprinkle the cornmeal onto the pan and I could only think, 'Well you told me to think outside of the box.' She was sitting in her wheel chair with her bed table in front of her. When I placed the home-made canvas where she was able to

reach it, Sister had no hesitation but with the first two fingers of her left hand started to move the cornmeal into a pattern. I knew I was in the presence of greatness and witnessing a new work of creation. She worked on this pattern with a sense of knowing she was accomplishing what she had wanted to accomplish for a long time. When Sister felt she had finished her 'masterpiece' she slid the pan over to me. I was busy shuffling through my bag and had not noticed her work.

'I made you a rose.' I turned and stared, shocked at the beautiful creation before my eyes! The cornmeal had been compressed and formed into the perfect shape of a rose."

It was to be her final masterpiece. One has to wonder if indeed it may be her most important piece. Art does many things; sometimes it moves people to action. Her flower caused the writing of this

story. Maybe it will cause each of us to look for hope and try to assist others in need.
