OBITUARY INFORMATION FOR

SISTER M. ANNINA FOX, SC

Date of Birth: March 12, 1919

SISTER M. ANNINA FOX, SC, age 91, who died at Caritas Christi, the motherhouse of the Sisters of Charity of Seton Hill in Greensburg, on December 16, 2010. A Pittsburgh native, Sister M. Annina entered the congregation of the Sisters of Charity on September 8, 1937, from Saint Philip Parish, in Crafton. Preceded in death by her parents, Peter E. and Mary M. (Kinney) Fox and a brother, Edward L. Fox, she is survived by cousins. Sister Annina earned a bachelor's degree in English, music from Seton Hill University and a master's degree in education, administration from Duquesne University. A teacher and administrator, Sister Annina instructed students in music in diocesan schools of Greensburg and Pittsburgh. Her longest tenure was at Saint Philip School, Crafton where she was principal from 1958 until 1964, and director of the boys choir and the adult choir from 1955 until 1964. She was vice principal at Immaculate Conception School, Irwin from 1966 through 1969. After she retired from the classroom, Sister Annina continued to teach piano, minister in the school library and assume leadership in the RCIA program at Saint Philip Parish. In 1997, Sister Annina received the first annual Distinguished Graduate Award from the Saint Philip School Alumni Association in recognition of her, "distinguished service to the Catholic Church and the United States." In 2001, she received the *Manifesting the Kingdom Award* from the Diocese of Pittsburgh in recognition of her, "exceptional way of manifesting the kingdom of God among us." Gentle and quiet, Sister Annina's life exemplified the words spoken by Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton, "Courage, hope and heaven. He goes before, who will crown our hope; but our suffering must be consummated, too."
